Name Badges - All Committee members will be wearing quilled badges and we hope you will also make one for yourself. Admiring them is an opportunity to meet other members and find out more about them. There will be a competition for the best badge.

Refreshments - Tea and coffee will be available all day from the village hall kitchen and at the Quill, Chat and Chill day. A five minute walk from the venue in Keyworth there are cafés, bakeries, etc., see Spring QT's map. However, you might prefer to take your own packed lunch(es).

Competitions - Competition entries **must** be in by 10.25 am and **must NOT** be removed before 4.00 pm. Please see competition information included in Spring 2022 'Quillers Today' - or email quillingguild@gmail.com - or send an A5 SAE, (at least 23cm x 16cm) to Jane Jenkins, 33, Mill Rise, Skidby, Cottingham, East Yorkshire, HU16 5UA.

Again, this year, the Originality rule will be waived for only Junior competitions and Beginners who have been quilling for fewer than twelve months only. This means that Juniors and Beginners may use a pattern designed by someone else, as long as they credit the designer. A notice will be available to be completed when handing in your entries to show the name of the designer, if not you, to be placed next to the entry. Entries in all other competition categories must be your own original design.

Regional and General Displays – So that we can supply the correct number of tables, please inform Jane by 30th June if you are bringing a Regional Display or items for the General Display. We are delighted to display any of your work, old or new. Please ensure that any quilling shown at a previous quilling celebration displays a red dot (supplied on the day).

Care of Quilled Items - The Committee does not accept any responsibility for exhibits, so it is the responsibility of members to care for their own display. We all need to be vigilant during the day, especially when the general public is in. We request that you, as a Guild member, watch over the work of others, as well as your own.

Photography - To reduce delays in the competition room photography, except by official Guild photographers, will not be allowed until after voting has taken place.

The Quilling Guild reserves the right to use any photographs of work submitted, displayed or received, in its publications and on social media, whether in paper format or digital format, including online publications.

Stewarding/Demonstrating - Each member is a steward and should keep an eye on all displays. Please observe the 'Do not touch' rule and respect the work of others.

Quill, Chat and Chill Day – This popular day of quilling will, as usual, be taking place on the following day, 18th September, at Keyworth Village Hall (address above). The cost will be £5 per person.

We hope you and your friends can join us in our Celebration of Quilling. On 17th September the cost of entry for Guild members is free and for non-members is £3, payable on the day, with accompanied children free.
