



The Higher Level Accreditation - Rules

Those applying for Higher Level Accreditation must:

- have been a Member of the Quilling Guild for at least 5 years.
- understand that the Guild can only accept up to two new Higher Level Accreditation applications per year, and applicants may have to wait in a carefully kept queue.
- send in the application form by the end of January 31st and work no later than March 31st.
- send £25 & postage (please ask for quote), made payable to *The Quilling Guild*, to: The Secretary, The Quilling Guild, 7, Downfield Avenue, Beverley High Road, Hull, East Yorkshire, HU6 7XE, UK, for the Higher Level Accreditation Pack, containing guidelines and working sheets, and £30 will be payable on application. Overseas applicants may arrange to pay by card or by PayPal account by emailing: quillingguild@quilling.karoo.co.uk.
- send a self-addressed label and stamps or equivalent cheque in pounds sterling, or arrange an alternative payment method for overseas, as above, for the return of work. We regret that monies are non-returnable.
- arrange and pay for sufficient insurance in the post/delivery service.
- ensure that work is sufficiently wrapped and protected in the post/mail or in the chosen delivery service; or otherwise, be responsible for the safe delivery and return of their work.
- understand that, while every care will be taken with quillings, the Guild cannot be held responsible for any damage incurred.
- understand that the Higher Level Accreditors' decision is final. No dialogue can be entered into regarding individual cases.
